References should be listed at the end of the document, following the order of citation in the abstract. Use Times New Roman, size 10, for the font, and align the references to the left. Each reference should be designated by a number in brackets [1]. When citing two references simultaneously, include them together as [3,4], separated by a comma. For three or more consecutive references, denote them with bounding numbers and a dash [1–4].
